Since God has called them to Germany in 2016, Zach and Natalie have been serving at the prayer center Karlsruhe and at a local church called CZK. Zach weekly leads a team that does outreach to spread the good news of Jesus and His love for all humanity.

To reach the younger generation and disciple them, they started a weekly meeting at their house called "Encounter Group". During this meeting, they eat together, worship, share a message from the word, and wait on God to listen to what He wants to say. This group started out with 10-15 people. Now up to 30-40, as the older generation heard about it and started coming regularly. They had to move the meeting to the local church building to have enough space for everybody. It is a time to come and feast at the table of the Lord.

Every two months Zach and Natalie organize a teen camp at the prayer center. This is where the young adults get to preach, lead worship, and disciple the generation after them.



Natalie has been pouring into the moms and children by organizing a moms group every week where mothers and children come to their house and meditate on the word of God and pray for each other.



The World Outreach Center was started almost 11 years ago, with most of the original planters having been touched by the fires of revival. We had dreams of worldwide expansion, with missionaries on every continent and teams being trained and sent out constantly. God had different plans. Most of the original planting team moved on to other ministries and life in general. A few of us press on at WOC, remembering the past – where we were touched by the fire of God for that season, but stepping forward – into the blazes God has set for the now.

WOC does not look exactly like we thought it would look, but neither do we. We do, however, look more like our parents, physically, than we did almost 11 years ago. Seems funny when you think about it, but it's inevitable. We all age and mature physically, and we should do the same spiritually. Things change day to day. Paul said in 2Cor 3:18, "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit." As we seek Him, we change; as we search for Him, we change; as we run after Him, we change; as we behold Him, we change; as we communicate with Him, we change; as we hold onto Him, we change; as we stay in His presence, WE CHANGE! We cannot help but change. The change is that we become more like Him –we TRANSFORM into the same image from "glory to glory" – really from place to place He has for us – from season to season of His presence. Don't wish you were where you were 2O years ago, or 1O years ago or even 1 month ago! Want to be in His presence NOW! Want to be unveiled and beholding his glory NOW! Want to be transformed NOW!

WOC is being transformed-changed into something other than what we originally thought it would be. We are adding to the sending and supporting of missionaries more outreach and church strengthening around the world. Within this very newsletter are indications of this wonderful Holy Spirit breathed maturation.

So, where are you? Stuck wishing you were where you were in a season in the past–maybe remembering fire of the past and hoping you had that fire back? Well, let me be the first to say, GOD has fire for you NOW! Behold Him with unveiled face and be TRANSFORMED!
