From the Desk of Dr. M. John Cava

"Be Sober, Be Vigilant ... Your Adversary the Devil Walks About ..." (1 Peter 5: 8-10)

Are you going about wondering, "Why are all these bad things happening?" You blame yourself, the people around you, the economy, the government, the germs and the list goes on. Often hopelessness sets in, futility grips you or false accusations cause greater problems. Distractions are some of his favorite methods, and all too often, they work. You feel like there is an invisible gray cloud over you (spirit of heaviness) from morning to night. Joy does not come easy. Yes, there are bad actors and difficult people. Yet in all this, the Bible warns us emphatically to wake up and be reminded, "There is a devil and his demons that are at war to "rob, kill and destroy... you (John 10:10)." He is relentless in his attack on humanity, especially, Christians!

There is Good News! You are not the only one who is experiencing this. Brothers and sisters in Christ around the world have the same issue. We are to think soberly, see what is happening, *resist* the devil, get stronger, enforce Jesus' victory and destroy the works of the devil just like Jesus did. This is the destiny of the victorious Church (Matt. 16:18).

So, what does *Resistance* look like? It starts with awareness. You discern that a spiritual enemy is at work that you should have authority over in the name of the Lord Jesus. We are not just wrestling against physical things and people, but against spiritual dark powers behind the seen, Ephesians 6:12. Then do the following:

- 1. Thank God for his goodness
- 2. Praise the Lord for his greatness
- 3. Command the dark spirits verbally to back off in Jesus' name
- 4. Declare the Word of the Lord, his faithfulness and promises ... and don't quit!

This will initiate a change both in you and the atmosphere. James 4:6,7 puts it this way, "Submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you." The power of the blood of Jesus, the Word of truth added to some faith from you will win the day. Serve the devil and his minions an eviction notice.

Jesus Christ is still the same yesterday, today and forever, Hebrews 13:8.

We are going to Kenya June 13 to August 3, ministering in Nairobi and Bondo. Most exciting news is that my son, who's been a prodigal, has come home and re-dedicated his life to Jesus. Praise God! They are also expecting their first child in July. I am going to be a grandma for the first time!

Currently, we are seeking the Lord for more financial provision for our ministry. One thing we want to do is purchase a food trailer. We would like to take the food trailer to parks in poor communities throughout Juarez, Mexico. We would prepare and give out free meals as well as evangelize, minister, and pray for the people.

Brian and Ianine Weaver - USA / Germany / Tanzania We are currently pastoring at Holy Trinity Church in the metro area of Washington DC, a place God has specifically called us to in order to raise up a life-giving, vibrant and missional minded church to serve the greater DC area and the nations. About 8 years ago, God spoke to Zach in a dream that we would live in Karlsruhe, Germany. He said that He would give us a center for His glory. Faithful as He is, He gave us leadership of a church called the Christian Center Karlsruhe.

Our church vision consists of five crucial values:

- Jesus and me (John 17,3)
- Mentoring (2. Timothy 2,2)
- House to house (Acts 2,26)
- Gathering (Acts 2,46)
- Missions (Acts 1,8)

Our goal and primary work is to focus on making disciples with a passion for Jesus and His Kingdom taking over the world. We believe these different practical values are what we find in the book of Acts.
