In Instanbul, Turkey, I hit the streets where I talked and ministered to the Muslim community. In Kadikoy, I visited an amazing prayer room ministry. I prayed with a refugee from Syria and a young girl. She was so hungry to know more

about Jesus, I gave her the phone no. of someone in the prayer room ministry, since I was leaving that day. She called her within hours!

I spent two months working in a private school in Batumi. I was creating artwork and bulletin boards throughout the whole school. I had great favor, walking through the halls carrying His heart, changing the atmosphere where teachers and students were impacted. I a

teachers and students were impacted! I also helped in the classrooms loving on the children and teachers. People were drawn to the God in me that I was able to share the testimony of who Jesus is in my life.

Two precious ones that I was able to pray and prophesy on in Turkey.

This past trip I ministered in the streets, prayed, connected people to the local church, prophesied, planted seeds, cast vision, empowered and encouraged God's people, spoke in churches and taught English.



In Batumi, Georgia, I went and taught English in a one room house with sometimes as many as 15 children.

Also in Batumi, I went on a school field trip to a nursing home to minister to the
